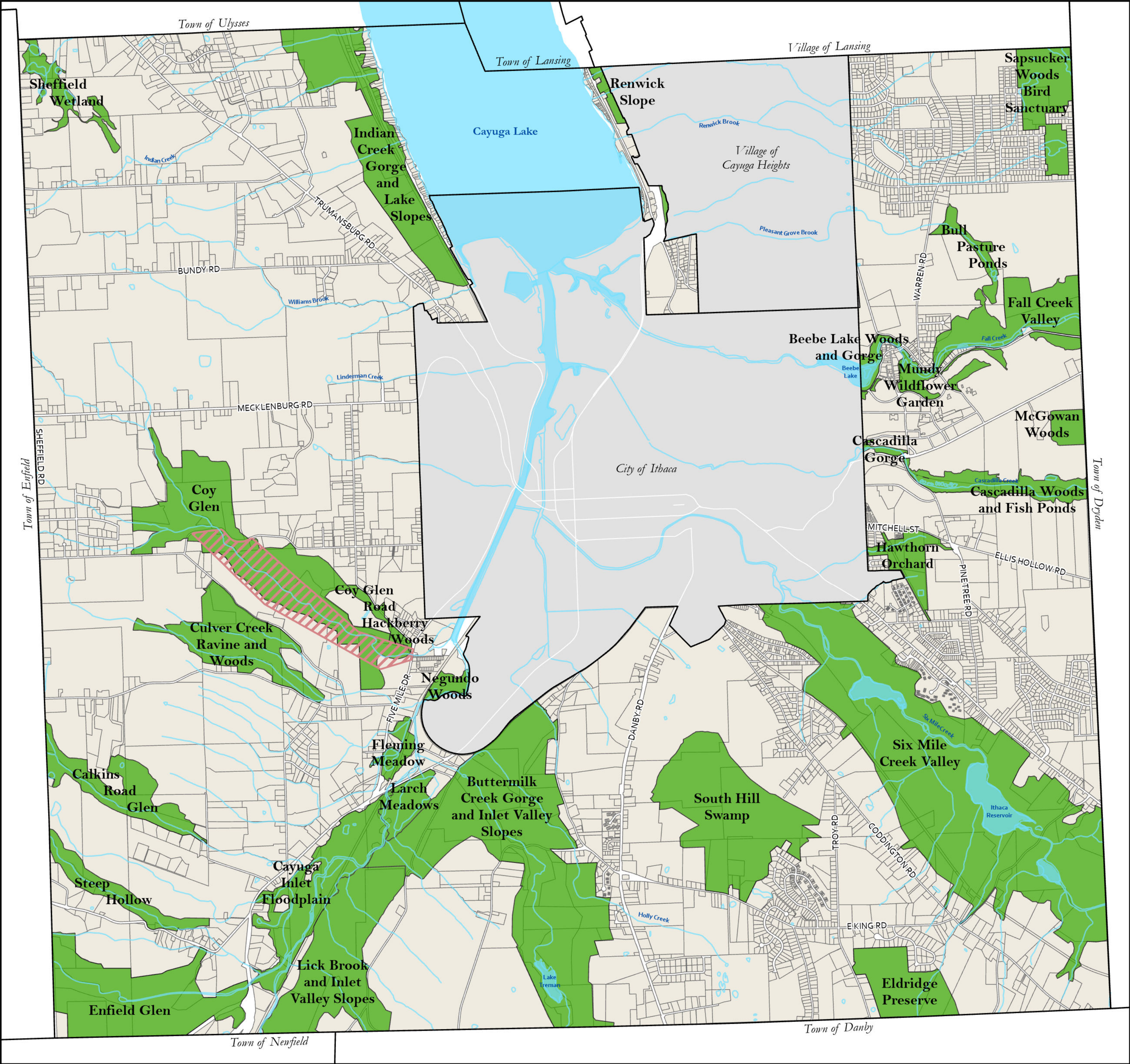


Unique Natural Areas and Critical Environmental Area Town of Ithaca, NY
